Contempt and Terrorism Penalty Warning

The Contempt Fraud Appeal 2020 1520 Case Management Email at 15.45 on 1st May 2021 from the Court of Appeal Civil Appeals Office Case Management Support Team Leader Joseph Goswell to Citizen Ms Berry read ‘Dear Sirs I am instructed to inform you to provide clear and concise grounds of appeal for the judge to consider. I therefore refer you to the following:

“Grounds of appeal **5**.

- (1) The grounds of appeal must identify as concisely as possible the respects in which the judgment of the court below is –
 - (a) wrong; or
 - (b) unjust because of a serious procedural or other irregularity, as required by rule 52.21(3).
- (2) The reasons why the decision under appeal is wrong or unjust must not be included in the grounds of appeal and must be confined to the skeleton argument.”

Case Management Email Response:

1. The Wrong + Injustice are explained by the words ‘Appeal grounds: Fraudulent Breach of Natural Justice + Human Rights + Overriding Justice Objective’
2. Contempt Claim Fraud 2019 004208 got an Appeal Jurisdiction Advice Order on 10th February 2021 for the Citizen and High Court against the State
3. The Appeal Jurisdiction Advice dated 11th February 2021 of State Counsel Mr Eardley stated that the Administration of Justice Act 1960 vested in the Supreme Court the Appeal Jurisdiction against Contempt Decisions of the High Court in spite of the fact the Supreme Court did not exist until decades later.
4. The Contempt Fraud Appeal of Citizen Ms Berry to the Supreme Court got Issue Denial Fraud Proof against the Supreme Court.
5. The Contempt Fraud Appeal to the Court of Appeal got Case Reference 2021 0317 on 22nd February 2021 and then that day use of the Appeal Jurisdiction Advice for a Jurisdiction Denial
