on 10th September 2021

Upon a Personal Appearance by the Claimant and No Appearance for the Defendant

Upon the Justice Priority imposing a Neutrality Qualification that requires Voluntary Disclosure of Conflicted Interests by everyone who claim Justice Management Powers.

Upon the House of Lords Case known as R v Clarke having in 2008 set the Universal Validity Precedent that validity has priority in every case

Upon the Law Courts having in 2015 used the High Court Case known as Emerald Supplies v British Airways having in 2015 set a Universal Conflict Disqualification Precedent that a Conflicted Interest is a Conflict Disqualification from All Justice Offices

Upon the Claimant having made the case that a Corruption Complaint and the provision of Professional Indemnity Insurance using the Institute of Osteopathy evidence Multiple Conflicted Interests and Conflict Disqualifications for the Claimant and All Registered Osteopaths against the General Osteopathic Council
