This writ was issued by the Plaintiff who resides at 10 Chippendale Gardens, BT10 0DX

Brief Claim. The 2022 Parliament Session Priority is Corruption Remedies using Special Measures against the State, Professional Authorities and Law Courts. The Plaintiff used his cases to get Proof Sets for the Special Measures Decisions against the Northern Ireland Authorities. He owned his home and half the probate estate left by his mother. A Fraud Conspiracy by State Officers and Law Court used a Benefits Termination Frauds, Benefits Appeal Delay Frauds and Rates Poverty Relief Denial Frauds for a Bankruptcy Fraud to steal his home and share of the probate estate. Resistance by him got Resistance Penalty Frauds by them. The Bankruptcy Trustee used a Bank Account Freezing Fraud to deny access to the Benefits Appeal Back Payment. The Fraud Conspiracy Claim is an Integrity Test Case that will get Remedy Proof for the UK Cabinet and Other Authorities or Remedy Denial Fraud Proof against them.
