Endemic Corruption is a Common Topic. Dismissal Execution against Law Court Judges will get Mass Publicity. Journalists will need to explain the Remedy Delays and Publicity Failures.

Corruption Proof and Remedy Denial Fraud Proof got Dismissal Decisions against Law Court Judges with Execution Responsibility against the Cabinet. Dismissal Failures were Protection Fraud Proof against the Cabinet. The Default Penalty was a Dismissal Decision against Prime Minister Mr Johnson. Dismissal Help Requests by Governing Majority Back Benchers got Help Refusals from Opposition Leader Sir Keir Starmer. The Refusal Reason was that in 2012 and Integrity Test got Protection Fraud Proof against him when he was Director of Public Prosecutions. The Cabinet and Opposition Leader made a Corruption Concealment Plan for themselves and a Corruption Exposure Plan against Law Court Judges. The Concealment Plan used Revenue termination Blackmail by the Cabinet and Big Business to get Corruption Non – Disclosure Propaganda Services by the BBC and Commercial Media. They made a Local Issues Only Agreement for the Local Elections. They made a Remedy Delay Plan until after Election Day and Coronation Day.

Record Frauds created the need for Personal Responsibility Proof against Identifiable Judges for Known Court Frauds. Tests Cases got Case Process Denial Fraud Proof against Supervision Judges and Audio Record Proof against Hearing Judges.

Journalists will need to explain why the Cabinet and Opposition Leaders provided Protection frauds for Organised Crime during the Election Campaign Period. They can ask Election Questions.

- 9. Did the Prohibited List include Remedy Denial Frauds by Local Court Judges?
- 10. Did the Election Agreement define Prohibition Breach Penalties?
- 11. Did the Election Agreement identify Prohibition Breach Penalty Enforcers?
- 12. Did the Election Agreement include anything else that Election Integrity Testers need to know?
