Notice of Hearing Date

The Court has relisted the directions hearing in this matter to take place **IN PERSON** at 2pm on Monday 18th November 2024 before Master Pester in Hearing Room 1 at the Rolls Building, 7 Fetter Lane, EC4A 1NL with a time estimate of 1 hour.

- Unless the court directs otherwise, an electronic hearing bundle must be lodged at least 2 clear days before the hearing. If the hearing is in person/hybrid or if the bundle is over 500 pages a hard copy bundle must also be lodged.
- For remote and hybrid hearings a list of remote attendees' names and email addresses must be filed in Word format 2 clear days before the hearing.
- This hearing will be recorded by HMCTS and you must not make any personal or private recording or publish any part of this hearing (which includes screenshots or soundbites), unless the judge has given you express permission to do so in advance of the hearing. To do so without permission is a contempt of court and a criminal offence.
