A decision has been made to recover control of Sussex Police from Organised Crime. Sussex Police Records prove Firearms Crimes - Cover Up Conspiracies that prove Organised Crime has controlled Sussex Police for years. Sussex Police stole firearms from Citizen Mr John Hoath, planned to use them to commit a serious crime, follow a false trail of guilt evidence and challenge him to disprove it. The plan went wrong. An Imprisonment Fraud gave him an alibi for the time of the planned crime. Sussex Police recovered the Stolen Firearms and a Firearms Cabinet with intent to cover up the theft by putting the Stolen Firearms in it. The cabinet was locked. They had no key. Sussex Police stored Firearms Receipts 220607 + 220 608 - Stolen Firearms + Locked Cabinet in Lewes Armoury. They committed many crimes to cover it up including a Firearms Possession Disqualification Criminal Conviction Fraud against Citizen Mr John Hoath.

Mr Justice Irwin made the 2011 Trafalgar Day Citizen Restraint Order to deny Shropshire Farmer Mr Ellis use of the courts and linked his Corruption Cases with the Sussex Firearms Crimes. Wealden MP made the 2011 Trafalgar Day Reference of Sussex Firearms Crimes to Secretary of State for Home Affairs MP Rt. Hon. Teresa May. As a result Court of Appeal Judges and the Home Secretary have before them Corruption Cases that prove Organised Crime controls Sussex Police, the High Court and the Court of Appeal

On 5<sup>th</sup> August 2011 Wealden MP Mr Hendry met Citizen Mr John Hoath who showed him a Sample 50 CCI High Velocity Long Rifle Stinger Rounds Firearms Possession Proof + Sussex Police Firearms Crime Proof + Bankruptcy Fraud Proof. His sons Young Constituents William Hoath + Edward Hoath witnessed it.

Retired Special Constable Mr Ian Wise declared he did not associate with criminals when applying for his Shotgun Certificate Renewal. At the Renewal Inspection a Firearms Officer received firearms, checked them against records, noted the last was stolen by Sussex Police and stored in Lewes Armoury from 2002 until 2009, realised the man who got it out of the firearms cabinet was Alleged Known Dangerous Criminal Mr John Hoath, fell silent and left hurriedly Sussex Police took no action to deny the Alleged Known Dangerous Criminal access to the firearms.

Young Constituents William Hoath + Edward Hoath addressed to the Queen, Prince of Wales and Lord Archbishop Canterbury a Corrupt Officer Dismissal Support Offer. They offered to make Firearms Certificate Applications relying on Bankruptcy Fraud Proof that the shooting rights at Summersales Farm remained vested in their father.

**Firearms Possession Proof** will not be disputed. Alleged Known Dangerous Criminal Mr John Hoath had photographs taken of him with a Sample 500 Winchester Subsonic Velocity 40 gr. Hollow Point Non Corrosive Rounds + a Sample 50 CCI High Velocity Long Rifle Stinger Rounds + .22 Firing Bolt + .22 Magazine + .22 Rifle.

**Intent Proof** The intent is to prove Organised Crime controls Sussex Police by their Case Management

**Validity Proof** The valid priority is for Neutral Jurors in Law Courts or Parliament Courts to decide Corruption Proof merits Officer Dismissals. The Lord Chancellor and Home Secretary can decide whether and if so when to intervene
