Statement of

The Father: Mr Akwasi Nkrumah

The Mother: Ms Laetticia Mukasa

The Children: Kenina Nkrumah born on 5th October 2009

Asafo Nkrumah born on 3rd September 2015

Ali Nkrumah born on 21st November 2016

The Paternal Grandmother: Alice Docherty of 8 Mandrake Way, Stratford E15 4PE + 07901 33328

[The Grandmother has Special Needs arising from a Kidney Transplant]

Child Welfare is the first and paramount consideration all Family Cases.

The Father provided Care Services for the children. He provided Basic Care, burnt off their energy with Sports Training and helped them make friends by use of the Breakfast Club and Sports Club.

The Children are old enough to know what they want. It is

1. *Child Care Services by the Father and*
2. *Child Welfare Priority Breach Remedies from the Authorities.*

The Mother decided to exclude the Father from the lives of the children.

Crime Complaints by the Mother against the Father got Harassment Investigation 01KW6359 and Witness Intimidation Investigation 01KW140125. They got Bail Conditions that ignored Child Welfare. They were a Child Welfare Priority Breach.

The Bail Condition Appeals by the Father got Process Refusals by the Law Courts. They were Child Welfare Priority Breaches.

Harassment Restraint Claim by the Mother against the Father was a Child Welfare Priority Breach because it failed to mention the Child Care Dependency on the Father. It got Case Reference CM25F90597. The Defence + Paternal Care Applications by the Father got Hearing Denials and Without Hearing Restraint Orders by the Family Court. They were Child Welfare Priority Breaches.

The Children told the mother they want a resumption of the Care Services provided by the Father.

On Saturday 5th July 2025 the Mother took the Children to see the Maternal Grandmother. The Mother said the Children and Father could have access to each other provided the Mother was not involved in it.

On Thursday 10th July 2025, a Sports Day Attendance by the Father for Ali got use of the Family Court Restraint Order for a Restraint Breach Complaint by the School Head. It got an Arrest + Custody + Investigation 01KG1226225 + Charge + Bail Conditions against the Father all of which are Welfare Priority Breaches against the Children

The Mother, Police, Council, Schools and Law Courts used State Powers and Court Powers to commit Child Welfare Priority Breaches. It was Contempt of All Superior Authorities with Remedy Powers

The Children want Care Services by the Father and Welfare Priority Breach Contempt Remedies against the Authorities.
