The Regulations provide that an application is instituted by making complaint to a justice of the peace and requesting the issue of a summons.

Thank you for your previous correspondence confirming that:

- These proceedings are recorded under Court Reference [2600026217](#).
- They form part of a single bulk proceeding under Worcester City Council's name rather than an individual court record in my name.
- The summonses are issued after a Legal Adviser has authorised the complaint list submitted by Worcester City Council.

As my hearing is listed for 17 July 2026, I respectfully request access to the court records evidencing the statutory and judicial steps undertaken prior to the issue of the summons, together with clarification of the procedure followed by HMCTS.

As HMCTS has informed me that the summonses are issued following authorisation by a Legal Adviser, I seek the court records that objectively evidence the exercise of that judicial or delegated judicial function in these proceedings.

Accordingly, I would be grateful if HMCTS could provide copies of, or make available for inspection, the following court records:

1. The complaint made by Worcester City Council pursuant to Regulation 34 of the Council Tax (Administration and Enforcement) Regulations 1992.
2. The complaint list submitted by Worcester City Council containing my entry.
3. The court record evidencing receipt of that complaint.

My enquiries arise because HMCTS has confirmed that a Legal Adviser authorised the complaint list prior to the issue of the summonses. I seek only to understand the court records evidencing that judicial or delegated judicial process.

For the avoidance of doubt, I am not requesting disclosure of Worcester City Council's evidence concerning the alleged council tax liability. My request is confined solely to the court's own records evidencing the statutory process by which these proceedings were instituted and the judicial or delegated judicial function exercised prior to the issue of the summons.

If HMCTS already holds documentary evidence lodged by Worcester City Council for the purposes of the hearing, I respectfully request the opportunity to inspect those documents before the hearing so that I may properly prepare my case, understand the issues in dispute, and avoid any unnecessary request for an adjournment.

9. You have stated that a Legal Adviser approved the issue of the summonses. What information was the Legal Adviser shown before giving that approval? I cannot speak on behalf of a Legal Adviser but I can confirm the content of the email was sent for review.
10. Was my name included on the complaint list considered by the Legal Adviser? Your name was included in the list attached to the email.
11. Did the Legal Adviser consider the complaint list before the summons addressed to me was issued? The council will await on the Court to confirm Summonses can be issued.
12. Is there any HMCTS record showing that the summons addressed to me formed part of the complaint list approved on 22 June 2026? I'm not clear what you're asking. If you are asking if the court has sight of the summonses prior or if you appear on the complaint list.
13. If there is such a record, may I inspect it? Clarity on the above will determine my answer here and for the below, however, you cannot inspect our inbox.
14. If there is no such record, how does HMCTS demonstrate that my summons was authorised before it was issued? The council await the court to confirm it can commence with issuing summonses.
15. Is there any document held by HMCTS which links my individual summons to Court Reference [2600026217](#)? The listing reference 2600026217 file contains the council reference you provided and is listed on the date you have been summoned to court.
16. If there is, may I inspect that document? You cannot inspect the file for it holds the personal information of others.
17. If there is not, how does HMCTS identify that my summons forms part of those proceedings? The council have The Summonses are issued by the council. You have confirmed that the summonses has informed you to attend Worcester Magistrates Court on the 17th of July.
